20:10 – 21:10 Panel Discussion - Prospects for EU-India Security Cooperation

This session looks to explore specific common security challenges faced by the European Union and India, and how the two regions can cooperate to find common solutions. The panel will discuss three themes. First, Radicalisation and Terrorism: both the EU and India have faced their devastating effects. Countering these challenges requires a continuous exchange of ideas, information and approaches, increased coordination and cooperation within and between states and shared understanding of the drivers of radicalisation. Second, West Asia (the Middle East): the fragile political, economic, and social environment of the region provides a breeding ground for conflict as well as transnational criminal networks smuggling drugs, people and weapons. Europe and India both rely on the Middle East for oil and gas and millions of Indians work there. The internal dynamics of the countries of West Asia, regional divisions and foreign interventions, have profound implications for India and the EU. And third, Maritime Security: enhancing maritime governance in the Indian Ocean, countering illegal activities (piracy, smuggling, IUU fishing), improving the safety of navigation and sustainably managing maritime resources are areas that require effective international cooperation.
